

Covid Protocol for Antigone

Antigone was filmed at the Northcott Theatre in April 2021 with strict Covid measures in place including:

Testing

All members of the Antigone company (cast and creative team) were tested at regular intervals by the University of Exeter's LFT's system. A negative result was required to take part in the project.

Hands

Hand sanitiser was provided upon entering the building and all participants were asked to wash or sanitise their hands frequently.

Masks

Masks were worn by all cast and company whilst in the building (unless performing).

Dressing Rooms

Hand sanitiser and anti-bacterial wipes were available in all rooms. Windows were kept open as much as possible.

Backstage

One way systems were implemented and a limited capacity on rooms was set.

No visitors were allowed back stage for any purpose.

The cast and company used their own cutlery/cups/plates and stored separately.

Working Bubbles

The Student Chorus were considered a 'Bubble' whilst working in the Northcott Theatre. As such they were able to be closer than the normal 1m+ social distancing requirements, however they were encouraged at all times to follow the normal rules when working with other members of the team

Cleaning

The theatre was deep-cleaned using multi surface cleaner and IPA wipes at the end of each daily session.
