

This year, we piloted Tech Futures. Supported by the European Union Social Fund, the programme is a gateway into a technical theatre career, made up of workshops offering practical, hands-on experience, introducing participants to the range of technical skills and roles involved in putting on a theatre production or other live event.



## NORTHCOTT KICKSTART COMPANY

This year also saw the inception of the Northcott Kickstart Company, a training company led and guided by Associate Director **Yusuf Niazi**. Working alongside the Northcott's professional teams, participants get first-hand experience in all aspects of theatre making.

The Kickstart Company first performed together in August with *The A Game*, an innovative outdoor comedy show exploring the hurdles that young people go through to reach adulthood. In October, they will also perform at Exeter Fringe Festival with a new piece of theatre in collaboration with Making Waves Theatre, *How Did I Get Here?*

Our Box Office and auditorium have an accessible hearing system, which transmits audio to hearing aids or specially provided headphones (which can be collected from the Box Office). The system can also be accessed via the Sennheiser MobileConnect app. which is available on both iOS and Android devices.



#### BY CAR

All parking on campus is run by the University and is 50p after 6pm Mon – Fri, and all day on Saturdays and Sundays. All permit signs may be ignored after this time.

At the time of printing, the only payment option is through <code>PayByPhone®</code>, via their website, phone number or app, available from the App Store or Google Play. We are working with the University to enable visitors to the theatre to purchase parking tickets through us at the time of booking.

Nearest to the theatre are car parks C & D, located only a few minutes' walk away. At busy times and for larger events, it may be necessary to park in car parks A & B, which are an 8-10 minute walk way. Please be aware that the campus gets very busy during working days, so parking is very limited for weekday matinees.


